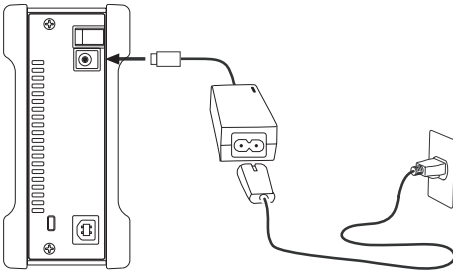
# Windows 2000 and Windows XP Installation



## Step 1. Install the OneTouch Software


 You must have Administrative Privileges. Refer to chapter 3 of the User's Guide for more information.

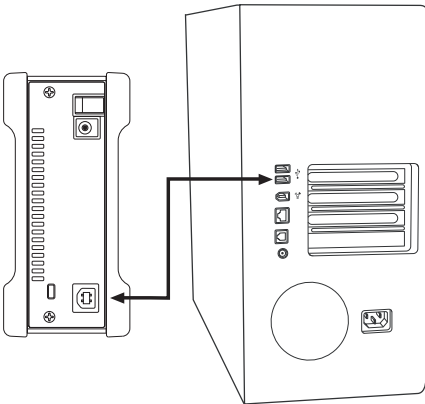
1. Insert the Install CD.
2. Wait for the Maxtor screen to appear.
3. Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software. Refer to chapter 2 of the User's Guide for more information.
4. After completing installation, eject the CD. Do not remove the CD until all steps of the installation are complete.

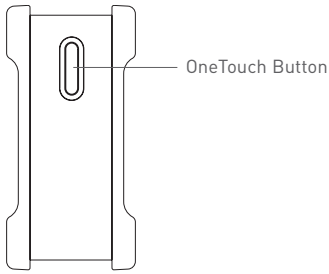


## Step 2. Connect the OneTouch III

1. Plug in the power adapter.
2. Turn the power switch on.
3. Connect a USB 2.0 cable from the OneTouch III to the corresponding port on your computer. Refer to chapter 2 of the User's Guide for more information.

 Allow up to 2 minutes for your computer to recognize the Maxtor OneTouch III.





### Step 3. Set up the OneTouch Feature

1. Push the button on the front of your drive.

The Maxtor OneTouch Manager will open to the Backup Settings menu. Follow the on-screen instructions to configure your backup.

Your installation is complete!

You may now back up your computer:

- Perform a backup at any time by pressing the OneTouch button, or
- Right-click on the Maxtor icon in the System Tray and select Back up now, or
- Allow Maxtor Backup to automatically run at the next scheduled backup time.
